



Defeat Cancer Saturday July 10 River Paddle,

Hi everyone! We hope you are looking forward to the 2nd annual DEFEAT Cancer river paddle.

WHAT: Paddle the Deschutes River from the Harper Bridge, on Spring River Road, to the Sunriver takeout point (just above the Benham Falls Day use Area) in your canoe or kayaks. This paddle is about a 3 and one half hour leisurely paddle through some beautiful scenery. This will be a relaxing trip taking in the beautiful views and enjoying everyone's company. This section of the river is flat and very safe. Thousands of people float this section of the river every year and have a great time.

WHEN: Saturday Morning July 10th. We will meet at the Sunriver Marina at 9:00 AM.

BOATS: You are encouraged to bring your own kayaks or canoes if you have your own. If you don't have a boat you can rent them at the Marina the morning of the Paddle. No reservations are necessary however I have given the Marina a heads up on the number of boats that will be rented and will update that number in the next few days. The cost of rental is \$65 for a canoe (holds 3) and single kayak and \$90 for a double kayak. The cost of rental includes a Personal Floatation Device (PFD) for each paddler and transportation for the boats and paddlers to the Harper Bridge put-in location and from the Sunriver take-out point back to the Marina. If you bring your own boat there will be a \$10.00 fee to transport it and you to Harper Bridge put-in and back to the Marina from the take-out point. Note: if you have a mirror finish glass boat that you have spent years building they recommend bringing some old towels to protect the finish from the steel arms on the trailers.

PREPARATIONS: Hopefully the weather will be warm and sunny but if it is otherwise please be prepared with appropriate clothing. Don't forget to bring the sunscreen, sunglasses, insect repellent, PFD, hats, gloves (to keep the chafing/blisters at bay), camera, water and snacks. A dry bag is wonderful to keep everything dry if you have one.

PICNIC/FOOD: Everyone is invited to come back to Jeff and Penny's house for a picnic after the paddle. Jeff and Penny will provide flavored turkey burgers, chips, iced tea,

beer, and a comfortable and fun environment for people to mix and mingle. Kids are of course welcome. We have a play set, horse shoes, and bocce ball. Each group is asked to bring a side dish or dessert and any special drinks that they want. 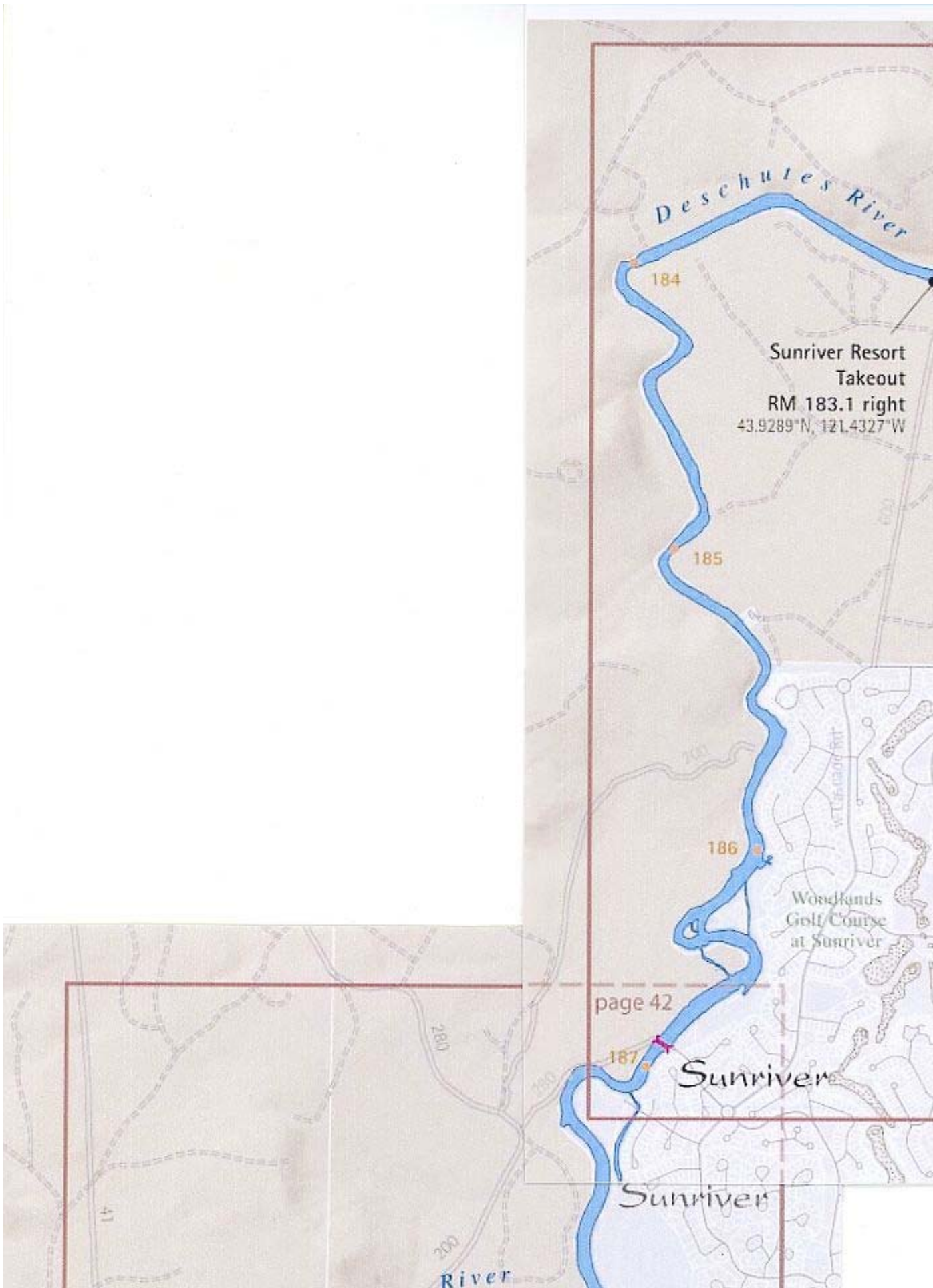
Directions to Sunriver Marina:
